Tips and suggestions for optimising your Webside Manner

- Set-up
 - Ensure a private setting by using a head set and closing doors & windows
 - Use a neutral background and keep the lighting in front
 - Dress professionally
- Introductions
 - Introduce yourself and show patient your photo ID
 - Verify patient's name and review consent
 - ❖ Ask if there is anyone else present
- Non-verbal cues
 - Maintain "eye contact" with the camera and not with the patient
 - * Remember facial expressions are exaggerated on virtual platforms
 - Advise patient that you need to type or look away to see their record
- Wrap-up
 - ❖ There is no "door knob" moment, allow time when winding up.
 - Summarize consider using the chat function
