- Assisting at major Surgery
- Incision and drainage of Abscess (assist)
- Nasogastric tube insertion (students should attempt to log an authentic experience; simulation accepted if necessary)
- Rectal Exam, digital
- Surgical knots (hand and instrument)
- Urinary Catheter Insertion - female
- Urinary Catheter Insertion - male

# Must See's

## Patient Encounters

*It is expected that the student will likely encounter the following:  
(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- Abnormal radiographic findings on abdominal plain films
- Acute abdominal pain
- Hematuria
- Masses presenting in the neck / chest / abdomen / inguinal region
- Perianal disorder
- Peripheral vascular disease
- Post – op fever
- Post – op respiratory distress
- Post – op wound assessment
- Trauma diagnosis and management (students should attempt to log an authentic experience; simulation accepted if necessary)
- Urinary retention / obstruction
