Patient Encounters

It is expected that the student will likely encounter the following:
(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)

- Abdominal pain, acute
- Acute dyspnea
- Acute agitation
- Alcohol use / abuse / withdrawal (medical perspective)
- Chest pain, acute
- Cutaneous manifestation of systemic disease
- Delirium / confusion
- Dizziness / vertigo
- Fractures / sprains
- Headache
- Impaired visual acuity or other important eye abnormalities
- Injured / red eye
- Shock / hypotension (eg GI bleed, sepsis)
- Stroke / TIA
- Substance use / abuse / withdrawal (medical perspective)
- Syncope
- Vaginal bleeding
