- Excision of a small skin lesion and / or punch biopsy (Observed)
- Injection administration (eg Immunization, flu shot)

(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- Back pain
- Cellulitis
- Chronic pain
- Cough
- Cutaneous manifestation of systemic disease
- Diabetes – outpatient management
- Dyslipidemia
- Dysuria / UTI
- Ear / upper respiratory tract infection
- Falls in the elderly
- Fatigue
- Hearing disorders (including tinnitus)
- Ischemic heart chronic disease
- Medication review
- Obesity, adult
- Palliative care
- Skin lesion, including cancer
- Smoking (or substance) counselling
- Weakness
