## **MEDICAL STUDENT DUTY HOURS & IMPORTANT DATES**

## Did you know that there is a policy on medical student working hours?



<u>Policy 010</u> defines scheduling for students in required clinical learning experiences. Key details on working hours include:

- Students can work a maximum of 11 hours on days when not on call and no more than 55 hours a week not including evening, night or weekend call.
- On-call (evening, night and weekend) should not exceed an average of one-in-four. This frequency should be distributed as evenly as possible across the clinical rotation or elective.
- Students are automatically excused before 10:00 a.m. post call.

## Where are my medical students today?

There are a number of important dates, including call protected time for Year 3 Students. In Entrada\*\*, you can view by following: Courses -> MEDD 431 -> Schedule and Orientation Info -> Important & Call Protection Dates.

- Call Protected Dates Includes the call protected time for sessions, exams and events that students must attend.
- **Timeline of Important Events** Includes important Year 3 dates and events, including breaks:
  - o Year 3 Winter Break December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025
  - **Year 3 Study Week & OSCE** May 26<sup>th</sup> May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025
  - **Summer Vacation between Year 3 & 4 –** June 1st July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025

**Academic Half Days** – Students attend these educational sessions during Year 3 Clerkship. Contact your Program Administrator for specific dates and times.

<u>Statutory holidays observed by UBC</u> –These are the dates that students may be off or, if they are scheduled, require time off in lieu.
