Must See's Patient Encounters

It is expected that the student will likely encounter the following: (Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)

- Alcohol use disorder (Psychiatric Perspective)
- Anxiety disorder
- O Bipolar / mania
- Child behaviour and development problems
- Depressive episode
- O Neurocognitive disorder e.g. dementia
- Personality disorder
- O Psychosis
- Sleep disorder
- Substance use disorder, overdose/poisoning (Psychiatric Perspective)
