## Clinical Procedures

*Students should have the opportunity to participate in the following:  
(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- ☐ Assisting at major surgery
- ☐ Incision and drainage of abscess (Assisted)
- ☐ Nasogastric tube insertion (students are encouraged to perform the actual procedure; simulation accepted if necessary)
- ☐ Rectal exam, digital
- ☐ Surgical knots, hand and instrument
- ☐ Urinary catheter insertion, female
- ☐ Urinary catheter insertion, male

# Must See's

## Patient Encounters

*It is expected that the student will likely encounter the following:  
(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- ☐ Abdominal pain, acute
- ☐ Abdominal radiographic findings on plain film
- ☐ Abnormal pathology with clinical correlation (e.g. cytology, biopsy)
- ☐ Hematuria
- ☐ Masses presenting in the neck / chest / abdomen / inguinal region
- ☐ Perianal disorder
- ☐ Peripheral vascular disease
- ☐ Post- op fever
- ☐ Post- op respiratory distress
- ☐ Post- op wound assessment
- ☐ Trauma diagnosis and management (students should attempt to partake in actual experience; simulation accepted if necessary)
- ☐ Urinary retention/ obstruction
