## Patient Encounters

*It is expected that the student will likely encounter the following:  
(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- ☐ Abdominal pain, acute
- ☐ Acute agitation
- ☐ Acute dyspnea
- ☐ Alcohol use disorder / withdrawal (medical perspective)
- ☐ Chest pain, acute
- ☐ Cutaneous manifestation of systemic disease
- ☐ Delirium / confusion
- ☐ Dizziness / vertigo
- ☐ Fractures / sprains
- ☐ Headache
- ☐ Impaired visual acuity or other important eye abnormalities
- ☐ Injured / red eye
- ☐ Palliative care (including end of life care)
- ☐ Respiratory emergency / pneumonia / cough
- ☐ Seizure (eg febrile)
- ☐ Shock / hypotension (eg GI bleed, sepsis)
- ☐ Stroke / TIA
- ☐ Substance use disorder / withdrawal (medical perspective)
- ☐ Syncope
- ☐ Vaginal bleeding
