(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- ☐ Acid - base and / or ABG gas interpretation
- ☐ CAM (Confusion Assessment Method) score for delirium
- ☐ Chest X-ray interpretation
- ☐ Cognitive assessment (e.g. MMSE, MoCA)
- ☐ Complete neurological exam (including cranial nerves)
- ☐ EKG interpretation
- ☐ Extrapyrarnidal side effects physical exam
- ☐ Glucometer interpretation

Patient Encounters

*It is expected that the student will likely encounter the following:
(Students are encouraged to seek out these experiences.)*

- ☐ Abnormal CBC
- ☐ Abnormal Pathology with clinical correlation (eg cytology, biopsy)
- ☐ Acute dyspnea
- ☐ Ascites / liver failure / elevated liver enzymes
- ☐ Cellulitis
- ☐ Cutaneous manifestation of systemic disease
- ☐ Delirium / confusion
- ☐ Dementia
- ☐ Diabetic complications (eg DKA)
- ☐ Dysphagia
- ☐ Electrolyte abnormality
- ☐ Infections (including choice of antimicrobials)
- ☐ Malignancy
- ☐ Palliative care (including end of life care)
- ☐ Renal disease (eg AKI, CKD)
- ☐ Skin lesion, including cancer
- ☐ Venous thromboembolic disease
